Rituals (What we do)	Routines (How we do it)
Sharpening pencils	<ul> <li>Sharpen 3 #2 pencils at the beginning of the class period.</li> <li>Never sharpen pencils while someone is speaking.</li> </ul>
Raise your hand	<ul> <li>Raise your hand to speak, leave your seat, or to ask for permission.</li> </ul>
Asking a question	<ul> <li>Use patience while waiting to ask a question. Remember to raise your hand.</li> <li>Be sure your question is related to what we're discussing. If not, wait until our discussion is over to ask your question.</li> </ul>
Leaving your seat	<ul> <li>Raise your hand to leave your seat.</li> <li>Do not get up from your seat without permission.</li> </ul>
Stations and group tasks	<ul> <li>Group members are to stay on task and follow instructions.</li> <li>Group Members are to maintain an inside voice.</li> <li>Do not disturb the teaching station.</li> </ul>
Before Starting a classwork or homework assignment	<ul> <li>Write your first and last name and the date.</li> <li>Write your assigned number and section and circle it.</li> </ul>
Before I turn in my classwork or homework	Be sure you have checked to be sure you have done everything on the "Before I turn in my work" checklist.
Leaving the classroom (Restroom/water/office)	Students must sign out before leaving the classroom after raising their hand and being given permission.
