Our Story:

Diamond Lakes Elementary School opened in August 2006 and was named for the surrounding community. Located in Hephzibah, Georgia, our area gives the feel of a small town while still be very close to Augusta, Georgia. Augusta is the 3rd largest city in the state and is well known for the Augusta National Golf Tournament and Fort Gordon military base. Diamond Lakes is located exactly 6 miles away from Fort Gordon and 9 miles away from the historic downtown area of Augusta, Georgia. Most Diamond Lakes students move on to Spirit Creek Middle School and Cross Creek High School. As part of the Elite Eight school collaborative, we are able to partner with other schools to bring unique opportunities to our students and their parents. The 80 plus dedicated staff members serve nearly 600 students daily. Our "open door policy" supports a "GEM"-tastic partnership with our parents and community.

Our CCRPI stats:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in five main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
