At Glenn Hills High, students have access to a diverse and comprehensive curriculum of over 100 courses, spanning Advanced Placement, fine arts (including arts, band, and chorus), Navy JROTC, and CTAE Pathways such as aerospace, business and technology, entrepreneurship, cosmetology, sports and entertainment, marketing, and teaching. Recently, we introduced a Future Nurses' Program, which has already helped several students receive scholarships to local Certified Nurses Assistant (CNA) programs. We also boast competitive academic teams in mathematics (math team), academic decathlon, and debate. For first-generation students, our AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) program provides valuable preparation for college. 

The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers, and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures student achievement on indicators such as content mastery, student growth on progress, subgroup performance on closing gaps, and various areas including Lexile performance, attendance, and other academic based measurements.
