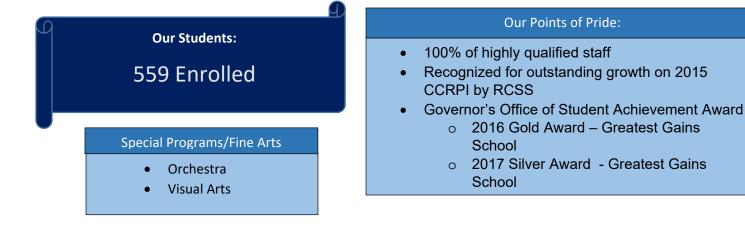


Gracewood Elementary School is located in Augusta, GA, the third largest city in the state. Augusta is widely known as the home of The Masters Golf Tournament. City attractions include the James Brown Arena and Fort Discovery. The Richmond County School System is made up of 55 schools and proudly educates over 32,000 students. Gracewood Elementary holds much history. The school was established in 1890 serving the families of the Gracewood Community in South Richmond County. Gracewood Elementary is credited with providing the first "school bus" in Richmond County. It was a horse and buggy that was driven by the school principal. The current school building still sits on the same grounds as the original building. Renovations and remodeling have resulted in the building as it is known today.



## Our CCRPI stats:

College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures progress on indicators such as content mastery, student attendance, and preparation for the next school level. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Schools may earn up to a set number of points in five main categories, for a total of 100 possible points.
