Richmond County Technical Career Magnet School (RCTCM) is a public school in the Richmond County School System (RCSS), providing technical and career programs, serving students in Grades 6-12, throughout the district. We also provide students Cybersecurity Training & Industry Certification through our Cyber Academy of Excellence. We are located at 3200 B Augusta Technical Drive.

Our campus is very unique from all other schools in the district as we share a campus entrance with Augusta Technical College. We are also located near Fort Eisenhower which allows our students to participate in internships with the National Security Administration (NSA).

We offer a variety of programs and services, including a college and career readiness program, a Fine Arts Program and a World Languages Pathway. We currently have approximately 47 students participating in Dual Enrollment with great hopes of students earning an associate's degree prior to completing high school. The Dual Enrollment program is a state funded program for all students in Georgia.






College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's statewide accountability system. The CCRPI assesses how well students are prepared for college and careers, and ensures that schools are focused on improving achievement among all students. The index measures student achievement on indicators such as content mastery, student growth on progress, subgroup performance on closing gaps, and various areas including Lexile performance, attendance, and other academic based measurements. Schools earn CCRPI points based on indicators that vary by grade and school level and align with measures of college- and career-readiness. Each individual component score is on a scale of 0-100.
