The **DMAT** club purpose is to enhance the learning process through the use of various media and instructional technologies. The mission is to teach and encourage student use of various media and technology tools to complete class and school projects.

DMAT club will consist of 4th and 5th graders. Fifth graders accepted into the club will meet the 1st and 2nd Tuesday of each month. Fourth graders will meet the 3rd and 4th Tuesday of each month. Meetings will begin at 7:30 a.m. and end at 8:10 a.m. Parents must ensure club members have breakfast and early transportation to school on club dates. Food is NOT allowed in the computer lab.

Because **DMAT** club meets in the computer lab, the club size is limited to 25 students from each grade level. Members will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. If your child is accepted you will receive notice, which will include a list of meeting dates, procedures, rules, and discipline consequences. Additional applicants will be placed on a waiting list in the order applications are received. Failure to attend meetings in a prompt and regular manner and failure to follow club rules will result in club expulsion. The next student on the waiting list will then be invited to attend.
