Student Achievement and Success

1. During the 24-25 school year, we will increase student content mastery in tested subject areas on the Georgia Milestones by 5%

2. During the 24-25 school year, we will increase the number of highly effective teachers and leaders retained in RCSS by 3%.

High Performing Workforce

3. During the 24-25 school year, we will increase post-high school readiness by increasing our graduation rate from 81% to 83%.

School Goals/Focus Areas

Goal 1 – (ELA) By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Barton Chapel Elementary will increase the overall placement score in ELA by 20% in grades K-5 from 38% to 58% as measured by the i-Ready assessment.

- Practice phonics, sight word fluency, and vocabulary daily.
- Read to students to build reading fluency, discuss story elements, and build reading comprehension skills.

Goal 2 – (MATH) By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Barton Chapel Elementary will increase the overall placement score in Math by 20% in grades K-5 from 17% to 37% as measured by the i-Ready assessment.

Practice number sense, fact fluency and problem solving daily.

Goal 3 – (CLIMATE) By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Barton Chapel Elementary school will decrease the number of major and minor office referrals by 20% from 197 behavior incidences to 157 behavior incidences as measured by Infinite Campus.

- Have my child practice basic math facts and work on grade level math skills.
- Have my child read books within his/her recommended Lexile range and ask questions about the reading to help with comprehension skills.

Barton Chapel Elementary students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed in school and aim to go the distance in math and reading. Students thought of the following ideas about how they can make the connections between learning at home and school:

- I will practice basic math facts. I will also use mental math strategies from Number Talks.
- I will complete my classwork and homework assignments.
- I will read for at least 20 minutes each night from a book within my Lexile range.
- I will give newsletters and other communications about school events and classroom instruction to my parents.
