## SET HIGH EXPECTATIONS

Let your child know that their education also matters to you.

Make sure you set the standard of wanting your child to work hard, graduate and figure out a plan for after high school.

Let them know it's okay to fail sometimes, but it's about the come back.

#### **MONITOR GRADES & ATTENDANCE**

Utilize Infinite Campus to stay in tune with real-time grades and attendance.

## **COMMUNICATE WITH TEACHERS**

Utilize email or schedule a parent-teacher conference to stay aware of your child's progress in the classroom.

#### ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILD TO SEEK SUPPORT

Talk to your child about academic opportunities for tutoring, make-up work, grade recovery. Utilize FEV tutor for additional support outside of school hours. If your child needs mental support, encourage them to talk to their school counselor or the school social worker.

## **GET INVOLVED**

Look for opportunities to support the school through clubs, groups, sports, or volunteer opportunities.

## TALK TO YOUR CHILD ABOUT WHAT COMES NEXT

Remind your child that high school is a stepping stone for the future. The years will go by fast and reality is coming soon. Talk to them about what next looks like for them.
