


# **E-Learning for Art**

Please complete one of the following art assignments for each day you should be in art. If you need any further help please ask an adult to reach out to your art teacher for you!




# Artist to Know: Tate Nation

Tate Nation is an artist from Charleston, South Carolina. He paints landscapes, buildings, and locations around Charleston.



#### Space

Space is an element of art. Tate Nation shows space in his art by creating a foreground, middle ground, and background. This makes his art look like it has depth and that there are objects close up and far away.

Color is an element of art. Jonathan Green uses very bright colors in his work. Color the picture above with bright colors.


#### Your Turn!




# Artist to Know: Vincent Van Gogh

Choose a room in your home to draw, then color or paint. Make sure you add thick and thin lines and bright colors.


#### Helpful tip:

Things closer to the bottom of the page will appear closer to the viewer, while things closer to the middle of the page appear farther away. These simple tips will help you create the look of space and depth.



# **Still Life Drawings**

#### What is a Still life?

A Still Life is a drawing or painting of objects. Artists arrange these items and draw them exactly as

they see them. There is often a light source near by to create high ights and shadows on the items.

#### Setting Up a Still Life


When setting up a still life you want to make sure you use a variety of items. They should overlap each other and be arranged in an

#### Value


Value is an element of art that describes the lightness or darkness of a color.






#### Your Turn! Set up a still life with objects around your home. Draw what you see. There should be different values in your drawing. Be sure to try

A piece of art that has land or natural area as the subject.


Artists use art to record parts of their lives, and one very important part of life for many people is where they live. There are many different styles of landscapes such as realistic, impressionist, and abstract.





# Portrait

#### A portrait is a piece of art with What is a Portrait?



a person as the main subject. Portraits can be created in many different styles.



#### Realistic

A realistic portrait is meant to look as close to real life as possible.

This is a very famous realistic photograph and often portrait called Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci.



**Stylized** A stylized portrait is sometimes less realistic than a displays each artist's distinct style, or

chosen artistic choices.

Abstract

An abstract portrait is created by the artist using unexpected shapes, lines, and colors. The key to abstract art is that viewer can still recognize what the subject is.
