Purchasing Your Tickets

1. Visit GoFan.com

Start by navigating to the website https://gofan.co.

2. Search Schools

Once there, look for a search bar dedicated to finding schools.

3. Type "Academy of Richmond County"

Enter "Academy of Richmond County" in the search bar.

4. Select the School

Click on our school when it appears in the search results to be directed to the ticket sales page.

5. Find the Game

Sending Tickets via Text Message

Sharing your tickets with friends or family is easy through text message. Follow these steps to convert an email address into an SMS or MMS:

Step 1: Obtain Recipient's Phone Number

Ensure you have the recipient's 10-digit phone number to direct the text message correctly.

Step 2: Determine the Recipient's Carrier Information

Use a service like FreeCarrierLookup to find out the wireless carrier associated with the recipient's phone number.

Step 3: Choose Between SMS or MMS

Decide if you want to send an SMS (limited to 160 characters) or an MMS (which can include more text and rich media).

Step 4: Find Carrier Gateway Email Address

Identify the appropriate carrier gateway email address based on the message type (SMS or MMS).

Step 5: Create the Phone Number Email Address

Combine the recipient's 10-digit phone number with the gateway address. For example, to send an SMS to a Verizon number, use 1234567890@vtext.com.

Step 6: Compose and Send Your Message

- 1. Enter the phone number email address in the "To" field of a new Outlook email.
- 2. Write your message in the body of the email. Leave the subject line empty if you wish to avoid formatting issues in the text message.
- 3. Hit send. The message will be delivered as a text to the recipient's phone, appearing as sent from your Outlook email address. If the recipient does not receive the message, ask them to check their junk or spam folder.
