# GRADING

<b>4</b> Advanced Understanding of the Standard	You add your own ideas, perspective, and style into what you do. You are confident and are reaching for the next level of proficiency.	
<b>3</b> Meets the Standard	You consistently meet the target proficiency level, and you are ready to move on.	
<b>2</b> Approaches the Standard	You can meet the target proficiency level in familiar tasks and situations. You know what to do to meet the target proficiency level, but you need extra help.	 
<b>1</b> Does not Meet the Standard	You know what the target proficiency level is, but you are confused and probably frustrated. You need some help to get started. You miss opportunities to demonstrate what you can do because you are often distracted, not participating, or absent.	 

2<sup>nd</sup> grade has a Standards Based Grading system. Here is a chart to assist in understanding the process.

\*N/A = the standard was not taught during this period

\*N/D= the student is performing significantly below grade-level





# TRANSPORTATION

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# SUPPORT SYSTEM

## Open-Door Policy

We believe in maintaining open lines of communication with both students and parents. We encourage students to approach us with any questions, concerns, or ideas they may have.

## One-on-one Session

We schedule daily one-on-one daily sessions to ensure every student receives the assistance they need. Intervention occurs in English/Language Arts and Math.





# WHAT'S IN YOUR CHILD'S FOLDER?

## Homework:

Students will have homework daily. If the homework has not been completed neatly, please encourage your child to do it over again, just as I would do in class.

Every Monday, your child will be given a Homework packet with details each night's assignments. PLEASE only allow your child to complete the assignments specified for that night. For example: On Monday, only complete Monday's assignments

## Conduct Sheets:

Conduct Sheets go home and must be returned with a parent's/guardian's signature to school each day. If a student comes to school without their conduct sheet or it has not been signed for two days in a row, he/she will have 5 minutes of structured recess.

Conduct sheets will include reminders, notes, and conduct grades.

## Reading Log:

The Reading Log is used to promote daily reading. Please allow your child to read to you 10-15 minutes each night. We will participate in reading challenges through out the school year.
