



















# GRADING

## WHAT'S IN YOUR CHILD'S FOLDER?

#### Homework:

Students will have homework daily. If the homework has not been completed neatly, please encourage your child to do it over again, just as I would do in class.

Every Monday, your child will be given a
Homework packet with details each night's
assignments. PLEASE only allow your child to
complete the assignments specified for that
night. For example: On Monday, only complete
Monday's assignments

#### **Conduct Sheets:**

Conduct Sheets go home and must be returned with a parent's/guardian's signature to school each day. If a student comes to school without their conduct sheet or it has not been signed for two days in a row, he/she will have 5 minutes of structured recess.

Conduct sheets will include reminders, notes, and conduct grades.

#### Reading Log:

the Reading Log is used to promote daily reading. Please allow your child to read to you 10-15 minutes each night. We will participate in reading challenges through out the school year.
