The Georgia Army National Guard offers 3 scholarship programs to go to college.

- 1. North Georgia College and State University (NGCSU) Georgia Military Scholarship
- 2. Georgia Military College (GMC) State Service Scholarship
- 3. West Point / United States Military Academy (USMA)Appointment
- The Georgia Army National Guard is allowed to give 42 scholarships to NGCSU and 42 to GMC to National Guard members that qualify.
- The primary qualification to be awarded one of the above scholarships is being able to join the Georgia Army National Guard.

<u>North Georgia College and State University</u> <u>Scholarship (\$97,000)</u>

- 1. You must have at least a 3.0 cumulative high school grade point average, and a 920 combined score on the SAT (480 critical reading/440 math) or a combined 20 on the ACT (20 English/18 Math)
- 2. You must qualify for regular admission to NGCSU.
- 3. You must be a member of the Corps of Cadets.
- 4. You must be nominated by a member of the Georgia General Assembly within the district you live.
- 5. You must be a current legal resident of Georgia.
- 6. You must meet mental and physical health standards required for enlistment into the Georgia Army National Guard.

<u>Georgia Military College</u> <u>Scholarship (\$57,000)</u>

- 1. Georgia Resident.
- 2. Nominated by state legislator.
- 3. Minimum 2.5 or higher cumulative high school grade point average.
- 4. Minimum combined SAT critical reading and math score of 800 or ACT composite of 17.
- 5. Be a Georgia Army National Guard member.
- 6. Be accepted to Georgia Military College.
- 7. Be a member of the Corps of Cadets

WEST POINT UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY APPOINTMENT (\$250,000) CODE NAME – OPERATION OPPORTUNITY

- 1. Be a US Citizen.
- 2. Be unmarried and have no dependents.
- 3. Be a high school graduate
- 4. Be between 17 and 23 years of age.
- 5. SAT scores of 800 or higher or ACT scores 20 or higher, and high grades of average or better.
- 6. Receive a recommendation from your Company Commander.
- 7. Be physically and mentally qualified for enlistment into the Georgia Army National Guard.

*The National Guard and Reserves receive 85 of these appointments annually.
