SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION

On-site Registration will be held on Tuesday, May 27th and Saturday, May 31st in the school's gymnasium between the hours of 10am and 2pm in the school's gymnasium. **Note: students who are pre-registered for summer school do not have to attend on-site registration.**

CREDITS

Students can take up to 4 classes (will earn up to 2 credits).

Example: 1 class = 0.5 credit, 2 classes = 1 credits, 3 classes = 1.5 credits, 4 classes = 2 credits

STUDENT ATTENDANCE & CONDUCT

Attendance will be taken daily for each period. Students cannot miss more than **two (2) days** to include off roll days. Students will be dropped from classes. Tardies to class will be calculated and count toward absences. The rules and regulations outlined in the Richmond County Schools Code of Conduct will govern summer school program.

TECHNOLOGY

Students will utilize their school issued devices for summer school instruction.

SCHOOL NUTRITION

The School Nutrition Program provides breakfast and lunch. Students are not permitted to leave campus

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided as a shuttle from district hubs throughout the school day. There will not be door to door or neighborhood pick up sites. The pick-up/drop off points will be the hub's bus loading zone. Public safety will monitor hubs sites. Students should arrive at hub sites at least 10 minutes prior to scheduled drop off time.
