## <u>iReady</u>

It is required students complete 30-60 minutes of Reading **AND** Math instruction per week in iReady. This will begin until after the first diagnostic test is administered. It is crucial that students complete their diagnostic tests INDEPENDENTLY with no help from parents. If I suspect that a parent interfered with the diagnostic test, then the student will need to be retested immediately. Please comply with this request.
