## Our Goals for Student Achievement

### *Richmond County District Goals*

1. During the 2022-2023 school year, we will utilize technology and the Richmond County School System Instruction Framework to increase academic achievement across all content areas by 3%.
2. During the 2022-2023 school year, through our Induction Support Program, we will increase the percentage of highly effective teachers and leaders retained in the Richmond County School System by 3%.
3. During the 2022-2023 school year, we will increase the graduation rate, from 73.77% to 75% by a continued focus on the strategy map and working to produce graduates that meet the Richmond County School System Profile of a Graduate.

### *C.T Walker Magnet School Goals*

- 📖 Reduce the percentage of students scoring 1 or more grade levels below in reading by 5% as measured by the EOY Iready diagnostic from \_ % to \_%. 2021-2022 school year results indicate that 46% of students were 1 or more grade levels below in reading on the BOY diagnostic. By reducing the percentage of students scoring 1 or more grade levels below, the percentage of students reading on grade level will increase.
- 📖 In order to establish an identity as a K5 school and to reengage parents in the school climate and culture following the COVID 19 pandemic, the school will host at least four major events during the 2022-2023 school year that will engage stakeholders in the school culture and climate. At these events, the goal would be to have an average attendance of at least 10% of the school's population.

### *Walker Area of Emphasis*

#### Language Arts

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade** - Read and respond to text dependent questions by writing ideas and information clearly, as well as using the text for support.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade**- Utilize root words, prefixes, suffixes, and context clues to analyze unfamiliar words, apply comprehension strategies to literary and expository texts.

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade**-Use of a variety of texts to formulate main ideas, inferences, and supporting details.

#### Math

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**- Addition and Subtraction within 1,000, Rounding to Nearest Ten and Thousand.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade**- Multiply and divide multi- and compare decimal fractions, digit numbers and understand decimal notations for fractions.

**5<sup>th</sup> grade** - Place value, multiplication, division, algebra, decimals,
