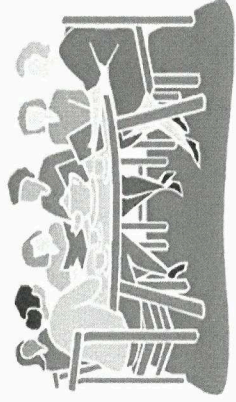


What is a School-Parent Compact?

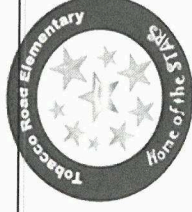

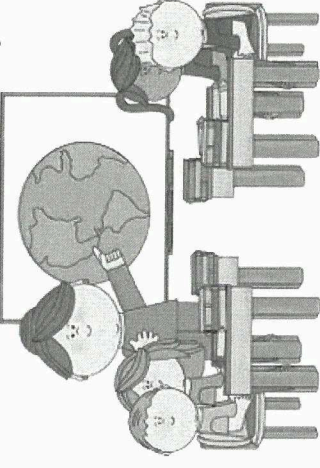

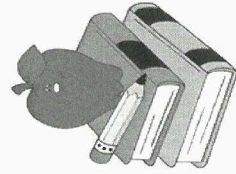

District Goals

By the end of the 2020-2021 school year, the percentage of students performing on grade level in all subject areas will increase by 3 percentage points as measured by district mandated assessments.

School goal(s) and focus area(s)

- I. Increase the number of students performing on grade level in ELA by 25% through targeted explicit instruction.
- II. Increase student attendance by decreasing the numbers of students absent for more than six days.
- III. TRE will use research-based strategies to increase the CCRPI from 47.9 to 50.1.
