➤ By the end of the 2018-2019 school year, the percentage of students reading on grade level will increase from 40% to 50%.

Comparing the 2017-2018 EOC to the 2018-19 EOC school year data, GHHS will increase the percentage of students performing at the pro



- ficient level or above on all EOCs by 3%.

 By the end of 2018-19 school year GHHS climate score will improve from one star to three stars.
- Comparing the 2018-19 CCR initial level to the 2018-19 CCR (College Career Ready) End-of-year level (Achieve 3000), the percentage of all students performing at the meet or exceeds levels will increase by 3% as measured by Lexile.
