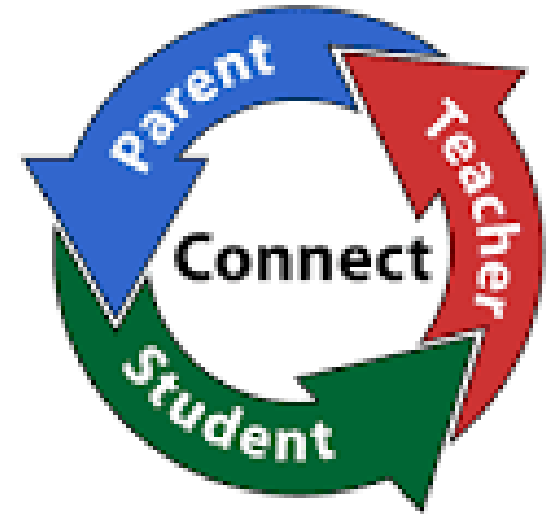

K-5th Grade School-Parent Compact

District Goals:

The system goals are...

1. By the end of the 2019-2020 school year, the percentage of students performing on grade level in all subject areas will increase by 5 percentage points as measured by district mandated assessments.

McBean Goals for 2019-2020:

- Increase Vocabulary to 655 on or above grade level according to IReady measured quarterly.
- Increase numbers and operations to 80 % according to IReady measured quarterly.
- Improve student attendance by decreasing the number of students missing more than 10 days (excused or unexcused) by 3 %.

Content Area Focus for Improvement:

K-5 Vocabulary:

- Implement FCRR vocabulary strategies in grades K- 2 to improve reading instruction to all students.
- Implement Sadlier Vocabulary workshop grade 3-5 to support students in acquiring new vocabulary , developing figurative language, word relationships, and nuances in word meanings.

K-5 Numbers & Operations:

- Implement Sadlier Vocabulary workshop grades K-2 to increase students' computational fluency.
- Use of Number Talks grades K-5

McBean Attendance:

- **SMART GOAL:** Decrease the number of student missing 10 or more days of school by 3%
- Attendance policy is posted on school website
- Attendance Incentives (Weekly, Monthly, Semester)
