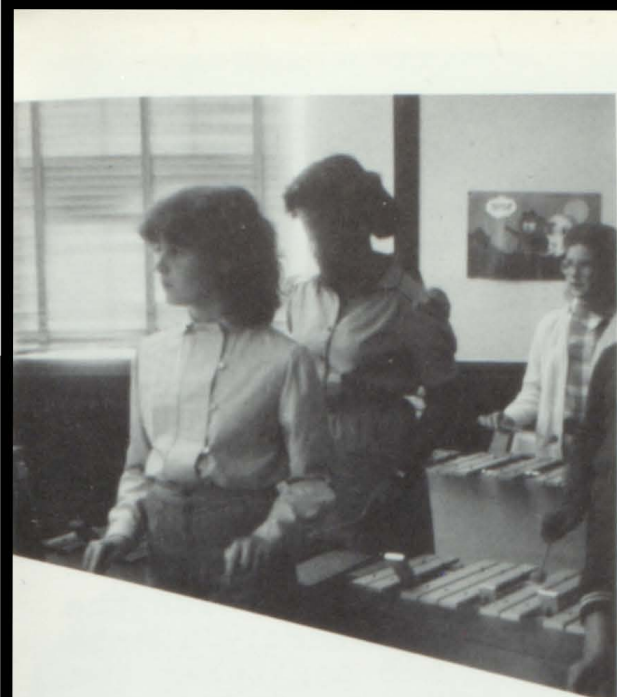


CLASS IN VOCAL MUSIC.

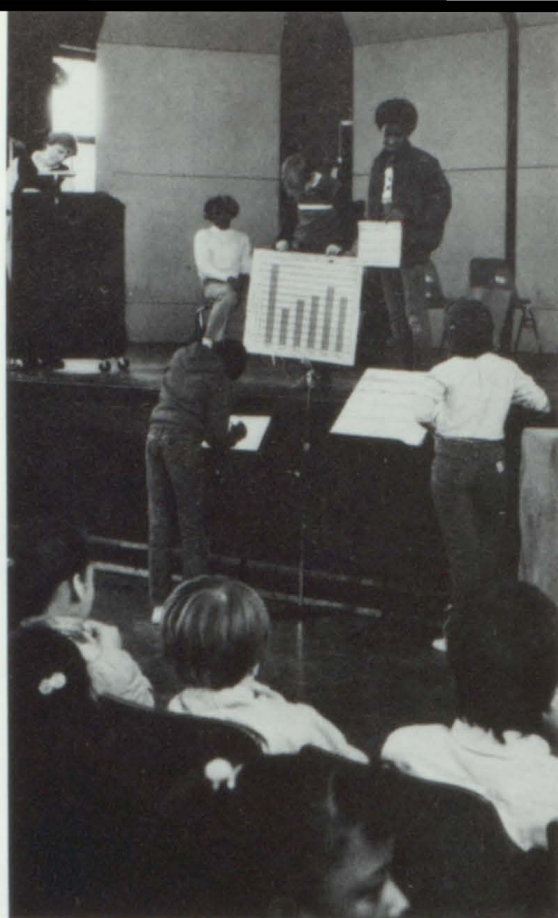
The Debate team placed third in the Literary Meet at Augusta College on January 26.

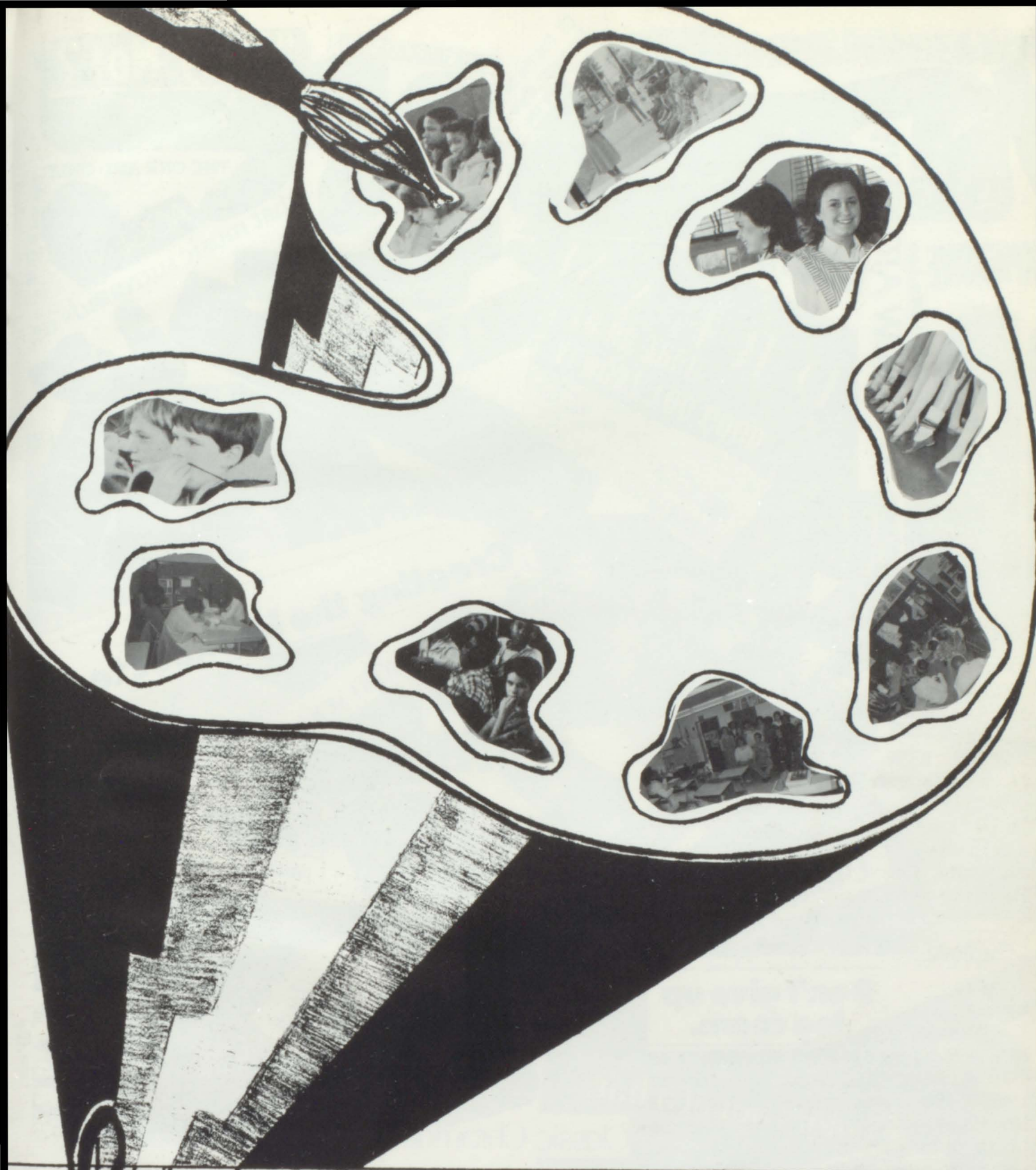
This year this school has had a growing time from new student and new faculty. The Board of Education is going to give us a permanent home...somewhere...sometime.
