

Seventh Grade Behavior Agreement



Classroom Rules

- 1. No phones or air pods are allowed to be out or in use while in the classroom.
- 2. Avoid eating any food or having any cans of soda.
- 3. Profanity is not tolerated; if you would not say it in church then do not say it in class.
- 4. Only speak when called upon by raising your hand and don't speak when your teacher is.
- 5. Keep your hands to yourself, and you should leave other people's stuff alone.

Classroom Procedures

- 1. Be respectful, prepared, and ready to work.
- 2. Enter the classroom quietly and begin working promptly.
- 3. Place your bookbag in the proper place.
- 4. Pay attention during instruction and avoid being disruptive/interruptive.
- 5. Remain seated, raise your hand, and stay engaged when working.
- 6. Desks are not to be used to write or draw on and keep your area clean.
- 7. The teacher's desk is not to be messed with.

Consequences for breaking Rules or Procedures

- 1. <u>Teacher Redirection</u>: individual warning with corrective measures.
- 2. Parent Contact: phone call or email home to parent or guardian regarding behavior.
- 3. <u>Referral to Counselors</u>: "get your life right" meeting with an assigned counselor.
- 4. Parent/student conference to implement a behavior plan.
- 5. <u>Teacher Detention</u>: assigned to serve before or after school if preceding steps are ineffective.
- 6. <u>Administrative referral</u>: if preceding steps do not work then it will be referred to administration.

Severe Disruption

Removal from classroom and referral submitted to school administration.
