Directions: Each day students will select **one activity** from **every subject** to complete. *For example, on Monday, students will need to pick an activity from ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, & Specials to complete.* They will continue completing work this way for the remainder of the week.

ELA	Read a book of your choice, then write a letter to one character from the story. Write at least 2 questions for the character to answer.	Sight word scavenger hunt. Find and cut out sight words from magazines and store advertisements (ex: Bi-Lo). Make a collage with the words.	Word Patterns Make a list of R-controlled words. Ex. ir, er, ar, ur, or Five of each. (ex.: bird, herd)	Read a book (Storylineonline.com) Write the story elements. Characters, setting, what happened in the beginning, in the middle and the end of the story.	Have some fun and make 10 nonsense words (cvc). Example: muz, sut
MATH	Create a story problem using the numbers 35 and 23.	Find 3 objects and put them in order from shortest to longest. Then send a picture to your teacher on class dojo!	Starting at the number 42, write your numbers backwards to 0.	Create, 3 different fact families. Here is an example http://34auburn.weebly.com/uploads/4/2/1/9/42193645/original-1843538-2-li_orig.jpg	Get a stack of playing cards, draw four cards. Use the numbers on the cards to make 2 two digit numbers and compare them using greater than and less than.
SCIENCE	Watch a video on Magnets Tell me something that you learned about magnets from the video. The Science of Magnets Video for Kids https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4I1WqXHkVgs	Find 2 things in your house that will attract a magnet and write down why they will attract the magnet.	Find 2 things in your house that will repel a magnet and write down why they will not attract the magnet.	Create a T-Chart and on one side put Attract and on the other side put repel. Cut out objects that will attract and repel magnets and place them in the correct column.	Have a Scavenger Hunt and find things that will attract a magnet.
