Directions: Each day, students will select **one activity** from **every subject** to complete. *For example, on Monday, students will need to pick an activity from ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies, & Specials to complete.* They will continue completing work this way for the remainder of the week.

ELA	Read a book of your choice, and then write a letter to one character from the story. Write at least 2 questions for the character to answer.	Write five nouns, five adjectives and five verbs.	Write 10 base words and then make them plural by adding an "s" to the end of the words.	Write a letter to your teacher.	Write down what you miss most about going to school.
MATH	Create a story problem using the numbers 27 and 13. Send a picture through class dojo!	Count out 100 pieces of cereal or another small food item. Place them in groups of 10. Write your numbers by tens up to 100. Send a picture through class dojo!	Starting at the number 65, write your numbers backwards to 0.	Create 3 different fact families. Here is an example http://34auburn.weebly.com/uploads/4/2/1/9/42193645/original-1843538-2-li_orig.jpg	Get a stack of playing cards, draw four cards. Use the numbers on the cards to make 2 two-digit numbers and compare them using greater than and less than. If you don't have cards, just make up your own two-digit numbers!
SCIENCE	Watch a video on light Tell me something that you learned about light from the video. What is Light? https://www.turtlediary.com/video/light.html	Draw a light source and explain how it brings light.	Find your shadow outside in your backyard and see what position the sun is facing. Explain what you discovered.	Create a T-Chart and on one side put Natural Resources and on the other side put Artificial Resources. Draw 3 light sources on each side of the T-Chart.	Have a Scavenger Hunt and find different light sources around your house.
