Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is shared with parents via the input/revision meeting and the Annual meeting. The plan will also be posted on the school Web site. Parents can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the Parent Resource Center.

- ✓ Increase the number of students missing 6 or less days by 10% by the end of the 2020 school year.
- ✓ Create a positive school culture that results in the school's climate star rating
