Class Rules


1. Bring all supplies/materials to class each day
2. Enter class quietly, sit in your assigned seat, secure your supplies, and complete your warm-up assignment as soon as you enter the room.
3. Complete all work/homework and turn in on times (on the due dates). **LATE WORK WILL LOSE POINTS OR NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE TEACHER** (at the teacher's discretion).
4. Keep all body parts to yourself and refrain from displaying disruptive behaviors such as tapping, singing, humming, excessive talking and getting out of your seat without permission.
5. Raise your hand and wait for permission to give your verbal input, ask a question, or get individual teacher attention.
6. Use your inside voice at all times—refrain from blurting out and yelling..
7. Respect all belongings of fellow students and teachers.
8. Respect those who are speaking by giving your undivided attention,
9. Participation is expected.
10. Cleanup your area after your closing assignment is completed or before you leave at dismissal.
11. Lines and silence are to be maintained in the hall for class changing, restrooms, lunch, connections, auditorium and drills.

Class Procedures

1. Complete all assignments using blue or black ink or #2 pencils on white, loose leaf notebook paper.
2. Make-up work is provided in the make-up work folders located on the back cabinet and on the teacher's website—Students are responsible for checking for make-up work during homeroom or at the end of class.
3. Place all items that need to be read, filled out, or signed by the teacher in the tray on my desk as soon as you enter class. Pick up these items at the end of class after class is dismissed.
4. Place all assignments in the designated place at the end of class including warm up assignments, daily assignments, and closing assignments. Homework assignments will be turned in as you enter the classroom on Fridays.
5. Passes will only be issued in EMERGENCY situations. Restroom breaks will be provided throughout the day.
6. Silent sustained reading will be done when work is completed.

Classroom Rules and Procedures

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- Homework will be given out on Mondays and will be due on Friday's
 - Any work not completed in class is homework and due the next morning.
 - Work missed while you were absent is provided in the While You Were Out folder and/or the teacher webpage. Students are responsible for checking for missed work at the beginning of class.
