Hello Class of 2021 Parents!

I am so excited to serve as the advisor for the Class of 2021! This class is very special to me because I taught most of them during my first year as a teacher. It is often said that junior year is the most important year. For students who will be applying to college next fall, junior year is the last full year of grades and activities that colleges will see. This can be a stressful time for students, but it is my mission to make sure the students balance it with enjoyable class activities. From the ring ceremony in fall to prom in spring, we have a busy year ahead of us. I want the students to have a memorable year, and I look forward to us working together to make that happen for them!

The Class of 2021 has a challenge that the other classes do not have. They are the smallest class, and they did not have a class advisor their freshmen year. This means that we are trying to play "catch up" so that we'll have enough money to fund class activities and prom this year. Class dues are \$40 per year. Students who did not pay freshmen or sophomore dues will need to pay freshmen, sophomore, and junior dues (total of \$120) before being able to participate in class activities. Students are not required to pay class dues. However, only students who have paid their dues will be allowed to participate in activities that are funded by dues, including prom, coronation, and other activities the students choose to have.

Prom ticket (venue, décor, food, etc. are funded entirely by dues)
Opportunity to serve on prom planning committee
Class cookout
Homecoming dance ticket
Homecoming cookout meal ticket

You may pay dues using cash, check, or the online payment system. Please make checks payable to Richmond County Technical Career Magnet School and put "2021 dues" in the memo line. Students may bring their class dues to me in room 243B. Please see Ms. Thomas in the front office if you would like to pay online.
