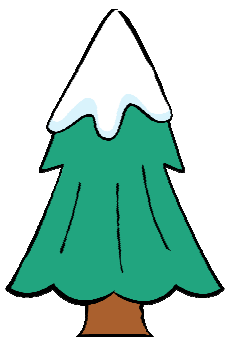

- Francine's light blue coat matched her hat that she had forgotten.
- Trey doesn't own a red coat.

SNOWMAN ACCESSORIES LOGIC PUZZLE

There are five snowmen on Perry Lane in Evatt's neighborhood, each at a different address. Each snowman has a different number of "buttons" going down it's front, and Evatt has a favorite accessory on each snowman (one was on skis) that he thinks makes it unique. Use the clues to determine the address, number of "buttons," and accessory!

Clues:

1. The snowman with the skis had more than 4 buttons.
2. The snowman with the cape and the snowman with the top hat were on the same side of Perry Lane.
3. The snowman with the scarf was located at 11 Perry Lane.
4. No address number matches the number of buttons for the snowman located there!
5. The snowman at 6 Perry Lane was wearing a hard hat. It had more than 4 buttons.
6. The snowman at 14 Perry Lane had 3 buttons, but it wasn't wearing a cape.
