O.C.G.A. 20-2-293 (2010)

20-2-293. Student attending school in system other than system of student's residence

(b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a) of this Code section or any other general law, and except as provided by the General Assembly by local law, a student shall be allowed to attend and be enrolled in the school in which a parent or guardian of such student is a full-time teacher, professional, or other employee, notwithstanding the fact that such school is not located in the local unit of administration in which such student resides. Each school system of this state shall provide procedures to implement the provisions of this subsection.

CONDITIONS OF EXEMPTION

INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

Attendance zones, as established by the Richmond County Board of Education, shall be one of the determining the factors in regard to the eligibility of a student desiring to participate in performance activities (athletics, band and auxiliary units, chorus, cheerleading, etc.). In order for a student to be eligible to participate in performance activities that are sponsored by the Richmond County Board of Education, State Board of Education, or the Georgia High School Association, during his/her four years of high school (grades 9-12), the student shall meet all the requirements of the above and abide by the residence requirements of Policy JBCC. Students granted official transfers to attend other schools <u>are not</u> eligible to participate in performance activities except as otherwise provided herein, or by board policy. Rules and regulations pertaining to academic eligibility are available at each local high school.
