<p>Seeds come in packs of 12. You have 3 packs-tomatoes, cucumbers, and peppers. Draw an array to show your garden. You must plant all of the seeds. Label where the different types of seeds are planted. Then Write a multiplication fact for the whole garden.</p>	<p>Create a poster showing 3 different strategies to solve <math>28/4</math> (28 divided by 4) - repeated subtraction, draw a picture, and use a related multiplication fact.</p>	<p>Every country has a different flag. Look at some examples of flags. Use at least 6 different shapes to create a design for a flag for your school. Make sure you include the school's name and mascot.</p>
<p>Create a city using only lines, line segments, and polygons. Label all of the roads and buildings. (use a ruler or straight edge)</p>	<p>Measure the area of a square or rectangular surface in your house (example: a desk)</p>	<p>Challenge: There are 365 days in a year and 24 hours in a day. Use a calculator and what you know about multiplication to find out how many hours old you are. Then check your mom's or dad's age too!</p>
<p>How does a clock's hand create angles? (Explain and use examples to support your answers)</p>	<p>Create a poster about how multiplication and division are related.</p>	<p>Create a song or a rap to teach your classmates a group of multiplication facts.</p>
