Attendance/Tardies/Makeup-work

Cheating

- If you are talking or sharing answers during a **graded assignment** (class work, test, quizzes, etc.), **without permission from the teacher,** you will receive a 0 for that assignment. **Unauthorized use of language translator/interpreter is also considered cheating.**

Student Evaluation:

A grade will be given for each assignment given in class daily. It is very IMPORTANT that students COMPLETE all given assignments daily. Daily assignments will includes but are not limited to the following activities; daily participation, homework, tests, compositions, speaking, reading, and listening exercises.

Late Assignments: All assignments that are submitted late will have points deducted from the final grade. The amount of points deducted will be decided by the teacher. Assignments that will be accepted late will be decided by the teacher. General daily classwork assignments and homework assignments will not

be accepted late, and student will receive a grade of 0 for those assignments if they are not submitted on time.

Tutoring: Flexible tutoring hours are available. Please schedule a tutoring session with your teacher one week in advance.

Retake Policy

Students are only allowed to retake tests. In order to retake a test, students must arrange with the teacher a time before or after school to take the test. There will be 2 types of test retakes.

- <u>Type 1: Test Corrections:</u> Students who score a 75 or higher on a test will be allowed to make test corrections and have half of the points that were deducted from their original grade added back to their grade.
- <u>Type 2: Test Retake</u> : Students who score below a 75 will be required to follow the following steps.
 - 1. Complete a Test retake form and have your parents sign the form.
 - 2. After you have returned your retake form, you must attend a tutoring session with the teacher and then you will be allowed to retake the test. The retake test will not be the same test that was originally given.
