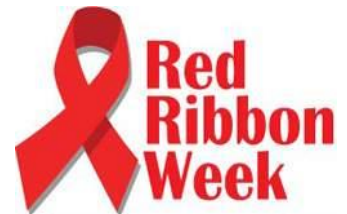

We are in need of parent volunteers, community members and business owners to serve on our School Council. If you are willing, please contact the Front Office. Your service is greatly appreciated.



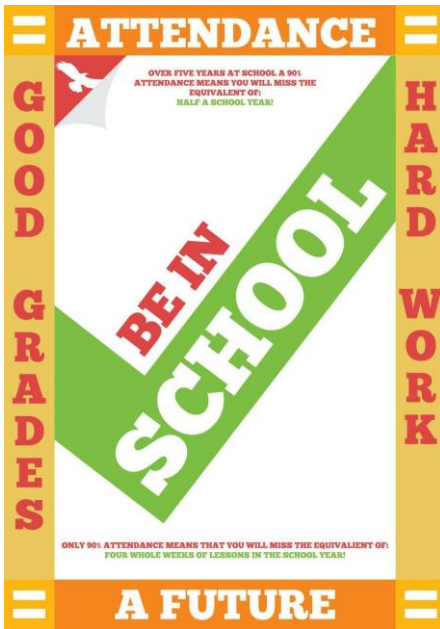
