Course Explanation

- **Beyond the Core Credit:** This measure is an indicator of a school's CCRPI score and is calculated as the percentage of students earning a passing score in specific courses. Students must take and pass at least one qualifying course each school year for the school to receive Beyond the Core points. Courses that qualify for the Beyond the Core points are indicated with an asterisk on the course offering guide.
- **EIP and REP course numbers:** Please ensure that students enrolled in the EIP or REP service models are selected for these courses based on outlined criteria.
- Elective requirements for elementary schools: All elementary schools, at the minimum, must offer Physical Education, Music, and an elective decided upon by the school from the list of approved additional electives.
- Elective requirements for middle schools: All middle schools must have, at the minimum, Physical Education, Health, CTAE, and Band. *Personal Fitness (36.0510000) is no longer offered for high school PE Credit in 8th grade. The course numbers in the charts represent full year courses. If an elective is a semester long course, the number utilized should end in 2X (with X being the appropriate grade level)
- **Elementary Course Length:** All academic content courses are year long courses. If elective courses will be scheduled for a semester, the course number should end in a 2X (with X being the appropriate grade level)
- Enhanced Algebra Concepts and Connections (formerly known as Algebra I): All HS math courses are
 undergoing a naming change due to the implementation of new standards for the 2023-2024 school
 year. Students successfully passing this course will receive HS credit.
- **General Music:** For middle schools that do not offer Chorus, Music, General (6th Grade- 53.0070006, 7th Grade- 53.0080007, and 8th grade 53.0090008) can be taught in lieu of chorus.
- **PE and Health**: These courses are required for all students. PE and Health can be scheduled as an A day/Bday for the entire year for both elementary and middle school students. Elementary students must attend PE on a consistent weekly basis. Additional recess is not a substitute for PE instruction. In middle school, if PE is taught for 1 semester and health for the other, the following course number should be used: 17.007002X (with the X representing the grade level of the students)
- **Spanish:** Spanish Exploratory can be taught at the elementary and middle school level. Spanish I (60.071000) for HS credit is no longer an option for middle school students.
- **SPED Courses**: SPED students should be scheduled for courses based on the Individualized Education Plan. Some SPED students may be enrolled in Study Skills (35.8170010-6th Grade, 35.8180010-7th Grade, or 35.8190010-8th grade) and/or Social Skills I-IV (35.8510010-35.8540080) based on the services written into the IEP.
