

 Review historical student data in Performance Matters to identify academic strengths, areas of growth, and habits of learning.






 Create a student interest inventory (that includes) learning styles) to learn more about strengths, extracurricular activities, and interests. Administer to students during the first week of school. You may also want to create a welcome video, contact students before school starts, prepare a getting to know you activity, and ask parents to complete an inventory about their student.



 Establish weekly check-ins to provide students the opportunities to reflect on how they are making progress toward their learning goals, identify area needing more attention, and consider whether they need to revise goals.
