VIRTUAL / IN-CLASS EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES

Virtual / In-Class Educational Outreach Opportunities refer to learning experiences brought directly to students—either through online platforms (virtual) or in the physical classroom (in-class). These programs are typically run by museums, science centers, cultural institutions, or subject-matter experts who “visit” the class to deliver engaging, curriculum-based content without the need for travel.

- **Virtual outreach** might include live-streamed presentations, interactive workshops, or virtual tours where students can ask questions and participate from their devices.
- **In-class outreach** involves educators or specialists coming to the school to conduct hands-on activities, demonstrations, or presentations right in the classroom.

These opportunities are great alternatives or supplements to traditional field trips, offering flexibility and access to high-quality educational experiences.
