- Task (14:10-3) - 10th graders will receive notification of the Georgia Dual Enrollment program information each year (flyers, website, e-blast, etc.).
- Task (18:11-4) - 11th graders will receive notification of the Georgia Dual Enrollment program information each year (flyers, website, e-blast, etc.).

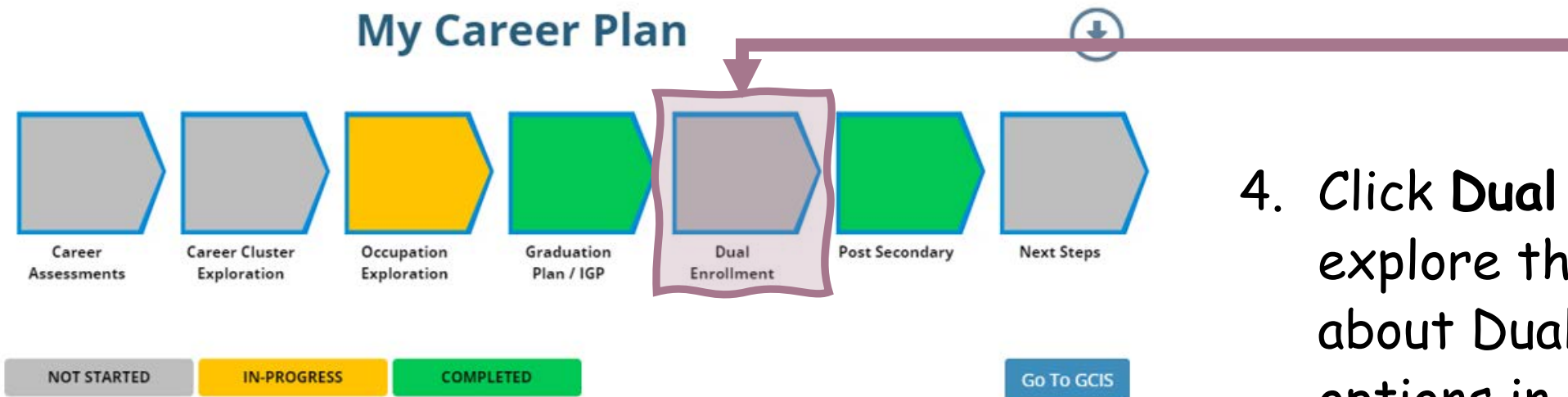
