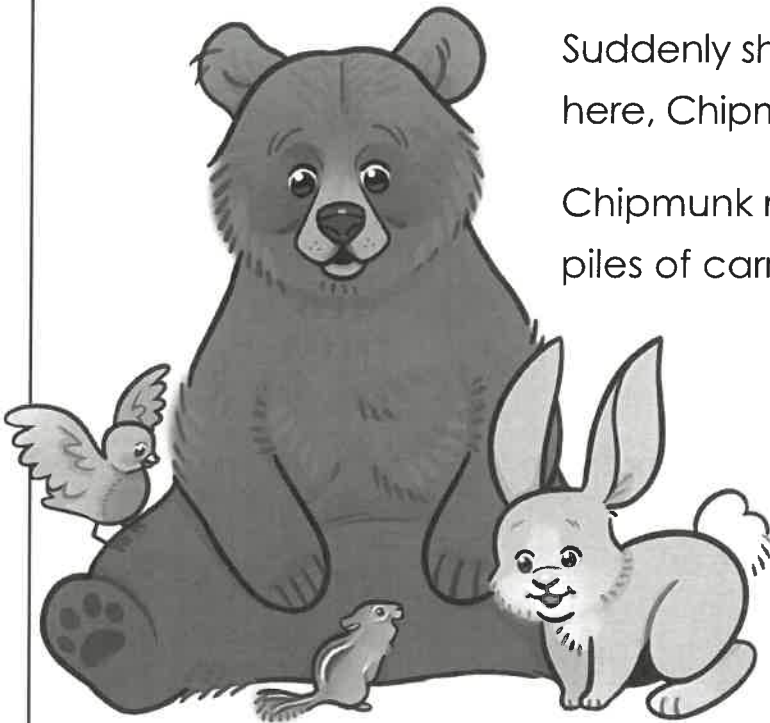
Chipmunk woke up. She was hungry.

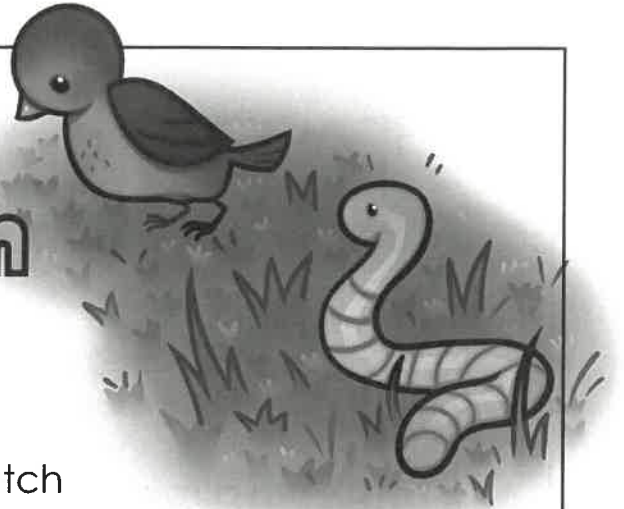

Bud did not see Will.

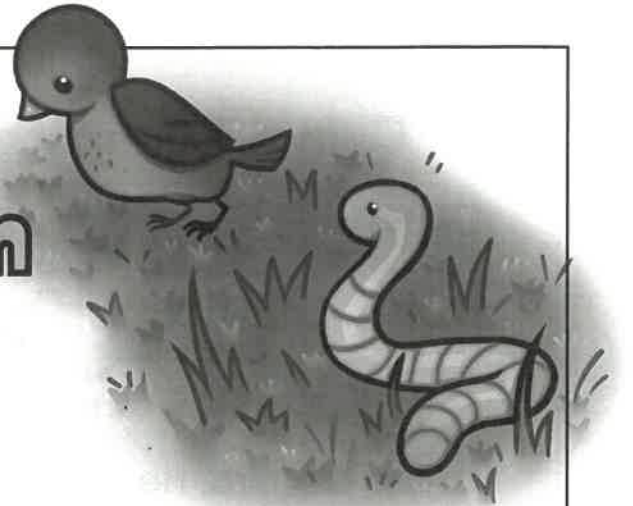
Bud flies away as Will pokes his head out of an apple that fell from the tree!
