CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS:

- Come prepared to learn
- No Bullying in the classroom or in the school building

COMMUNICATION/BEHAVIOR:

- Canvas and Classdojo will be used for all classroom behavior and communication purposes.

ATTENDANCE:

- Attendance will be taken daily. It is very important that your child attend school every day.
- If your child is late to school, they will miss important instructional time.

GRADING:

- Students will receive grading based on the RCSS Standards Based Report Card System.
- The purpose of this reporting system is to provide parents, teachers, and students with more accurate information about students' progress toward meeting standards. Parents will be more aware of what their children should know and be able to do by the end of each grading period.

Spelling:

• Sight words will be provided to help students with phonics and word recognition. Please ensure your child studies their weekly sight words.

HOMEWORK:

- Students will be given a homework sheet every Monday that will be due on the Friday. Please ensure your child completes his/her sheet every week.
- There will be a reading log sent home the 1st day of every month and will be due the last weekday of the month. Students should strive to read at least 20 minutes every day to help improve literacy skills.
- No homework, reading logs, or projects will be accepted late (unless the student is absent on the due date).

DISMISSAL:

- No early sign outs will be allowed after 1:30. If there is an emergency which requires your child to be picked up after 1:30, please contact Administration at (706)481-1813.
- If there is a change in transportation please send in a handwritten note, not a message in Classdojo or to the email address provided above. All notes will be verified by the Parent/Guardian on file.
