### **Final Exam Expectations for All Classes**

**This semester, Final Exams count 20% of the semester average. This also includes End of Course Exams. This is a large percentage of the student's overall grade and students must prepare.**

**These exams will cover standards that have been taught this semester. All students will have a Final Exam or End of Course Test. Students can exempt the Final Exam if they have a 90 average or higher. More information will be forthcoming for exemptions to final exams.**

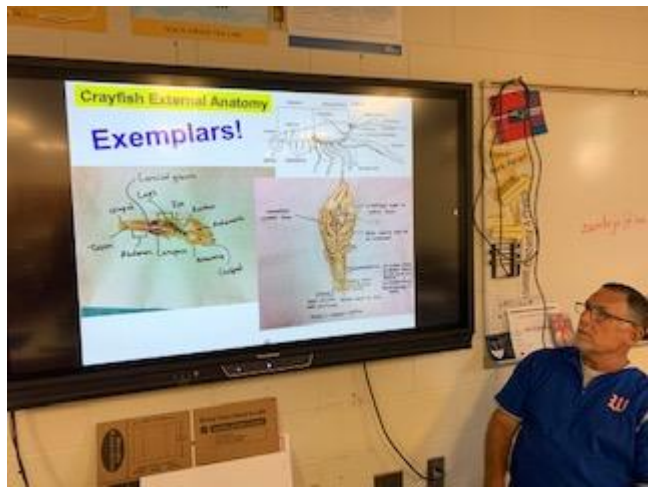








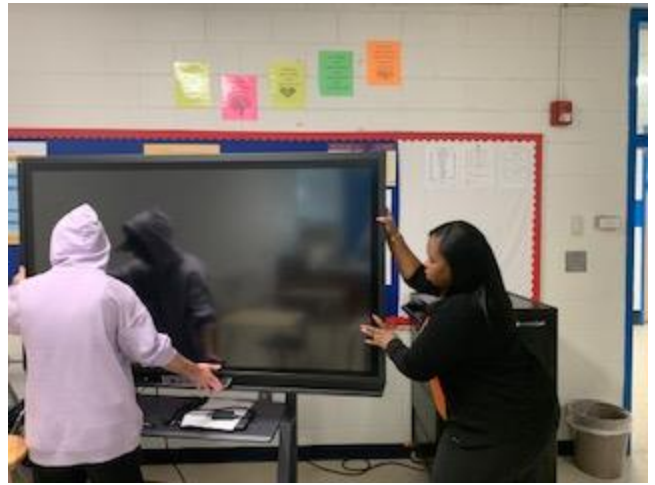

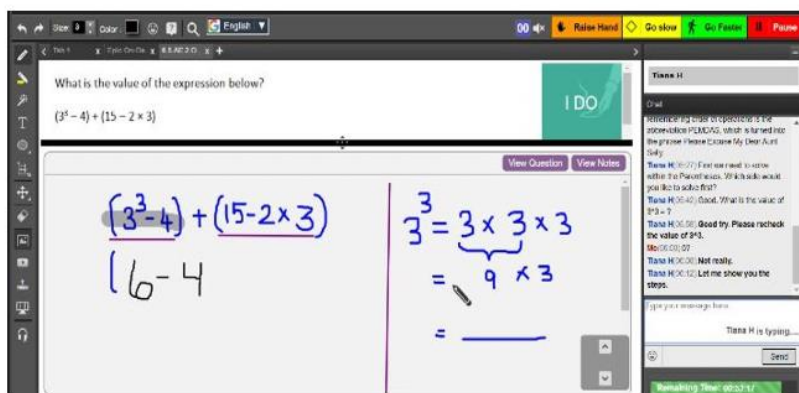
