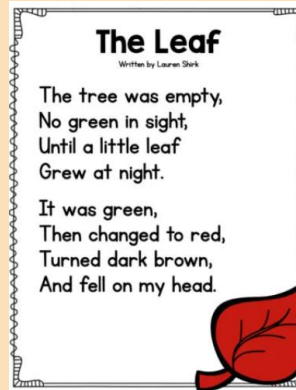


4th – 8th Fall Break Activities



3D Comprehension Pumpkins

1. Read a fiction book.
2. Print 3 copies of the pumpkin paper.
3. Pumpkin 1: On the stem write the title. On the line write a summary of the book.
4. Pumpkin 2: On the stem write the author. On the lines choose one character and write a character analysis.
5. Pumpkin 3: On the stem record the main setting. On the lines draw out a plot diagram for the story.
6. Cut out three pumpkins, fold each on half and glue them together.

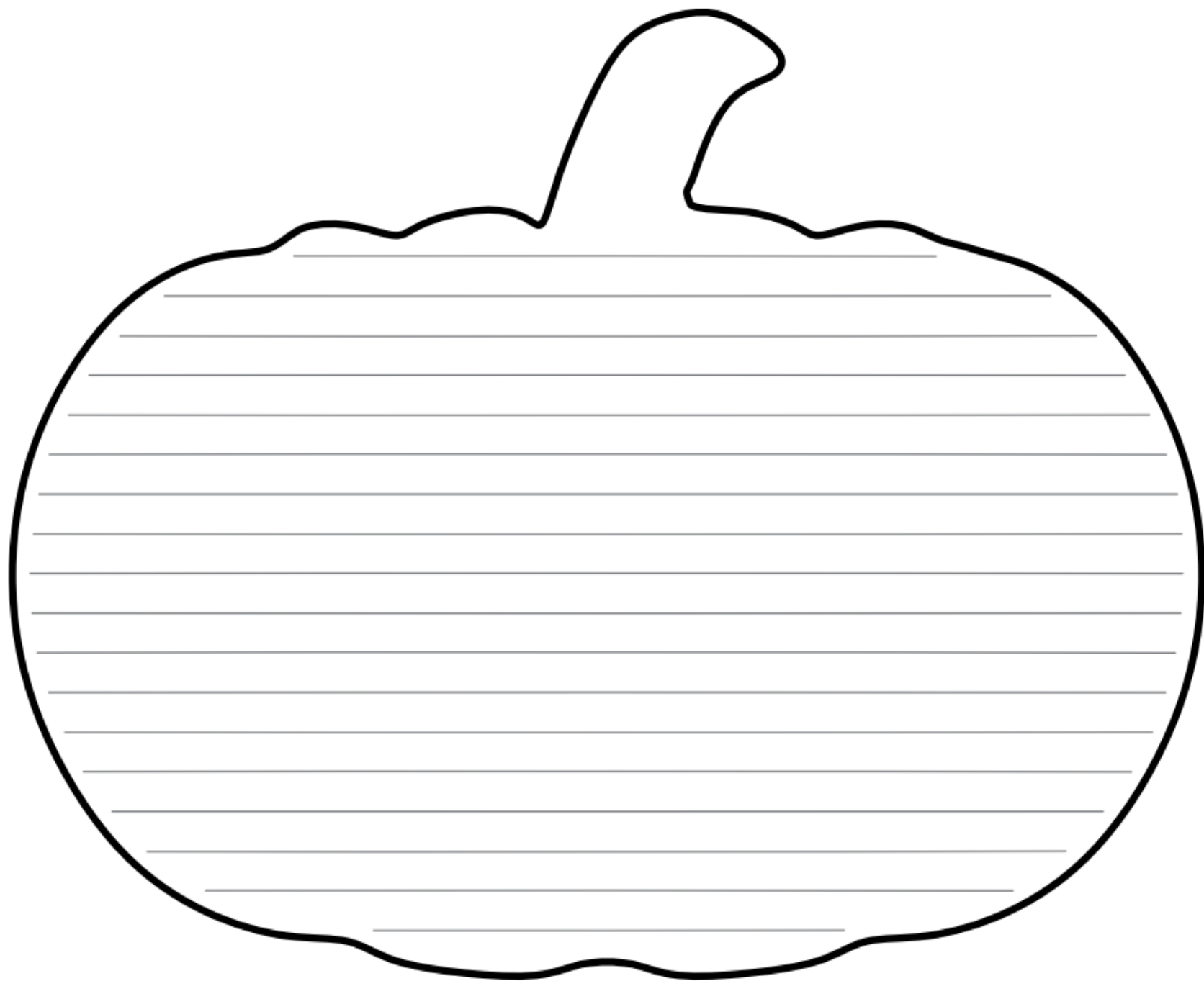
