Kindergarten & First Grade

Please work with your family to complete 1 or 2 activities each day. Try to complete a straight or diagonal row to win the game of bingo. Celebrate with a family game activity and a treat.

Find 5 things in your house that begin with the same sound as "Fall."	Mrite a sentence about your favorite fall activity AND draw a picture of it.	Count and sort a collection of small items in your house (coins, buttons, toys).	Oraw 3 things that change in the fall.
Clap out the syllables in 5 fall words (like pumpkin, apple, leaf).	Mrite your name use fall colored markers or crayons. Can you make a pattern?	Go on a shape hunt around your house. Tell a family member how many circles, triangles and squares you found.	Hop on one leg while counting to 20.
Go outside and collect 3 leaves and describe their colors.	Look through a newspaper or book and find as many cvc words as you can. Tap them out to a family member.	Count how many steps it takes to walk across your living room (or to the mailbox).	Draw a pumpkin and label its parts (stem, leaf, pumpkin)
Say 3 words that rhyme with "fall."	Ճ Write the numbers 1−20 in order. Practice writing them neatly.	Find 5 things that are the color orange.	Make a pattern with snacks (pretzel, raisin, pretzel, raisin)
Find 5 things that are shorter than your shoe.	A Trace your hand and turn it into a turkey.	Count backwards from 10 to 0, 20 to 0, or 30 to 0. Get someone to time you.	Pretend to be a falling leaf; move and twirl until you land.

*Read the same book to a family member for 3 days. Have them time you each day.
