- All AP course requests will be considered if you meet the 85 GPA/AP subject area expectation.
- If unsure whether an AP course is for you, speak with your teacher.
- **Make an appointment to meet with your counselor ASAP if you are interested in dual enrollment.**
- Guidance Counselors, teachers, and administrators are available for help and advice!
- There will be a drop/add period later in the year, but choose wisely now because classes fill up!
