Expectations & Policies

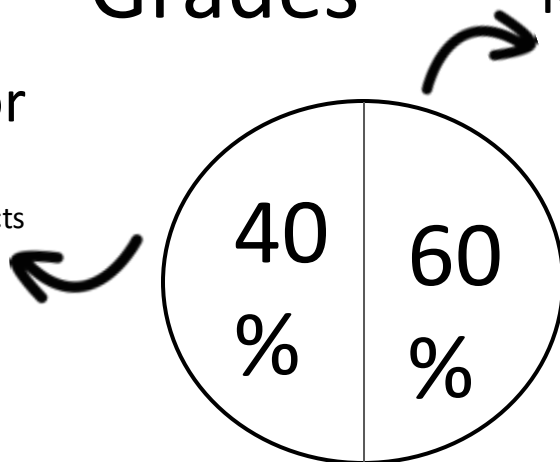


- 1. Be Prepared.** Come to class with your notebook, Spanish dictionary and all necessary supplies, before the bell.
