### **Book Character Day**

- -Faculty/Staff/Students are encouraged to come to school dressed as their favorite fictional book character.
- -Faculty/Staff/Students should bring the book that inspired their costume.
- -Faculty/Staff/Students should have read the book that inspired their costume. They should be familiar with the character they are portraying.
- -Note: All costumes must be appropriate for school (no masks, no gore, no weapons or look-a-like weapons, no super-scary costumes).

#### **Character Interviews and Introductions**

This is a two-part activity. During the first part, the students are meeting privately with a partner and interviewing them (in character). During the second part, classes will come to the library media center for the introductions (and pictures). Here's what to do...

- 1. Private Interviews (Classroom) Students pair up and take turns interviewing each other (in character). One person asks basic questions about where they live, when they were born, what they enjoy doing, and any other details relevant to the character. The other person responds from the perspective of the character. The interviewer jots down enough notes for a 30 second introduction and then they reverse roles.
- Character Introductions (Library Media Center) –
   Each person takes a turn introducing the character
   that they interviewed to the class. For example,
   "I'd like to introduce you to my friend, Harry Potter.
   He recently discovered that he's a wizard and began
   attending Hogwarts School to learn how to use his
   powers."
