Then, they add bubbles around the outside of the character to describe aspects of the character that can't be seen, such as...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Head – what he or she might be thinking about • Feet – where the character is going • Hands – what the character likes to do • Mouth – what the character is saying • Heart – who or what the character loves, or emotions the character feels <p>Student drawings should be displayed for the last two days of Read Across America Week.</p> <p><u>myON Read Alouds</u> Choose 6 myOn fiction books to read as a class. Individual students should take notes on the characters from each story. Use these notes for the Mystery Character Bingo activity on Thursday (March 1).</p>
