## **TEACHER LOGIN**

- Username = Please see Library Media Specialist
- Password = Please see Library Media Specialist

## **STUDENT LOGIN**

- Username = first initial, last name, last 6 of student ID (Example vnew123456)
- Password = first initial, last initial, last 6 of student ID (Example vn123456)



# GETTING STARTED: WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN STUDENTS FIRST LOGIN

WHEN STUDENTS FIRST LOG IN, THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO TAKE AN INTEREST INVENTORY (PERSONALIZED LEARNING)

NEXT, THEY WILL TAKE A 35 QUESTION LEXILE PLACEMENT TEST (PERSOANLIZED LEARNING). THIS TEST IS GIVEN ON GRADE LEVEL. IF THE STUDENT MISSES 4 QUESTIONS IN A ROW, THE TEST WILL END. THIS WILL ALLOW myON TO MAKE APPROPRIATE BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THAT STUDENT.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT FIRST AND SECOND GRADE CLASSES WORK ON THEIR INTEREST INVENTORY AND LEXILE PLACEMENT TEST AS A WHOLE GROUP IN THE COMPUTER LAB. SMALL GROUPS ARE APPROPRIATE FOR KINDERGARTEN, THRID, FOURTH AND FIFTH GRADES.

# MYON: BOOK RECOMMENDATIONS



## MYON: RICHMOND COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM'S NEW ELEMENTARY READING PROGRAM

- THE RICHMOND COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM'S MEDIA PROGRAM PURCHASED myON FOR EACH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR. EACH ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IS TO USE myON TO INCREASE READING INTEREST AND LEXILE SCORES.
- myON WILL COUNT AS PART OF YOUR SCHOOL'S MEDIA CENTER CIRCULATION.
- STUDENTS HAVE ACCESS TO 5,500 BOOKS ON myON.
- STUDENTS HAVE UNLIMITED ACCESS TO myON.
- > STUDENTS CAN ACCESS myON ANYTIME AND ANYWHERE. HOWEVER, TESTS TAKING WILL BE LIMITED TO THE SCHOOL DAY.
- >ANY DEVICE THAT CAN ACCESS THE INTERNET CAN BE USED FOR myON.
- >THE myON APP STUDENTS CAN LOAD UP TO 20 BOOKS AT ONE TIME. THE APP IS FOR READING ONLY, SO CERTAIN MYON COMPONENTS CANNOT BE ACCESSED VIA THE APP.

# **MYON: BENCHMARK TESTS**

STUDENTS WILL TAKE A BENCHMARK TEST FOR EVERY 5 BOOKS READ OR 3 HOURS OF READING WITHIN A TWO WEEK PERIOD.

BENCHMARK TESTS ARE GIVEN AT THE STUDENT'S LEXILE LEVEL. HOWEVER, EACH BOOK THAT MYON RECOMMENDS IS AGE APPROPRIATE FOR THE STUDENT, REGARDLESS OF LEXILE LEVEL.

IF THE STUDENTS DID NOT FOCUS WHILE TAKING THEIR LEXILE PLACEMENT TEST, THE BENCHMARK TESTS WILL PROVIDE AN ACCURATE LEXILE LEVEL FOR THAT STUDENT.



### **CLASSROOM – STUDENTS**

- UNDER THE CLASSROOM TAB, CLICK ON THE STUDENTS ICON. YOU WILL SEE YOUR CLASS ROSTER. NOTE THAT THERE IS AN OPTION TO CREATE STUDENT. YOU WILL NOT HAVE TO USE THIS FEATURE, BECAUSE ALL STUDENTS WILL BE UPLOADED TO myON VIA INFINITE CAMPUS.
- > THE STUDENTS ICON ALSO GIVES YOU THE OPTION TO ASSIGN A STUDENT TO A GROUP, DOWNLOAD YOUR ROSTER, AND SEE ANY REVIEW THAT YOUR STUDENTS HAVE WRITTEN ABOUT A BOOK (YOU MUST CLICK APPROVE TO APPROVE/PUBLISH THE REVIEWS THAT YOUR STUDENT HAVE WRITTEN).
- > IF YOU WANT TO VIEW AN INDIVIDUAL, DOUBLE CLICK ON THAT STUDENT'S NAME.
- > THE BOOK ICON WILL SHOW YOU THE LIST OF BOOKS A STUDENT HAS READ.
- > THE GROUP ICON WILL SHOW YOU ANY GROUPS THAT STUDENT IS A PART OF.
- > THE ASSESSMENT ICON WILL SHOW YOU A LIST OF TESTS (LEXILE PLACEMENT TEST, BENCHMARK TESTS) A STUDENT HAS TAKEN.
- > THE BOOK QUIZ ICON WILL SHOW YOU A LIST OF QUIZZES THAT A STUDENT HAS TAKEN AFTER READING A BOOK.
- > THE PENCIL ICON WILL SHOW YOU THE STUDENT'S ACCOUNT INFORMATION.

### **CLASSROOM - PROJECTS**

### CLASSROOM - PROJECTS

- YOU CAN ADD TAGS TO YOUR PROJECT. FOR EXAMPLE, YOU CAN TAG YOUR COUNTY WITH RCSS. YOU CAN TAG YOUR SCHOOL.
- YOU CAN ADD THE DUE DATE FOR YOUR PROJECT.
- YOU CAN INDICATE YOUR RECOMMENDED GRADE LEVELS.
- > ADDING TASKS
  - READING TASK: THIS IS WHERE YOU WILL ADD YOUR TASK CONSISTING OF ONE OR MULTIPLE BOOKS.
  - WRITING TASK: YOUR PROJECT COULD INCLUDE CREATINGA WRITING TASK FOR YOUR STUDENTS. THE TASK COULD INVOLVE A CHECKLIST USING THE ACES WRITING STRATEGY(ANSWER, CITE, EXPLAIN, SUMMARIZE).
- GRAPHIC ORGANIZER TASK: ADD A GRAPHIC ORGANIZER TO YOUR PROJECT. <u>ALWAYS REMEMBER TO SAVE YOUR PROJECTS.</u>
