#### Special Note:

1) Grades earned during dual enrollment affect your child's present high school GPA and future college GPA.

2) Students who fail to attend class without withdrawing or is withdrawn by a professor for non-attendance, will receive a grade of an IU on their college transcript and a 67 on their high school transcript.

3) Students can ONLY withdraw "W" from two courses EVER and could receive an "F" on their high school transcript.

4) Funding is provided for 45 quarter hours and 30 semester hours over 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

5) Students cannot retake failed courses.

6) Final grades of D's or F's WILL disqualify students from participation in dual enrollment.

\*\*Students who withdraw from college courses,

must be placed into classes at ARC.
