Applicants will be rated in the following areas:

- 1. Academic Honors
- 2. Non-Academic Awards
- 3. Extracurricular Activities
- 4. Volunteer Service
- 5. Personal Statement (250 words minimum)
- 6. Essay (500 words minimum, content, grammar, format)
- 7. Academic Performance/Scholarship
- 8. Recommendation Letters (one on school letterhead)

All applicants will be notified in writing on or before April 1, 2023, of selection results.

In order to receive the financial award, **recipients must provide their student ID number**, **official verification of enrollment at the accredited institution (from registrar, business office, advisement), and a current class schedule.** The award check will be mailed directly to the college/university financial aid office, payable to the student and the school after September 1st. Your student ID number must be included on the check.

Submissions must include the typed application form, typed personal statement, typed essay, official high school transcript (must be in a sealed envelope with an official signature on the seal), FAFSA (need-based only), and two letters of recommendation. Only complete submissions will be considered. Complete applications must be received on or before **February 28, 2023**. Put all documents in one envelope and mail to the following address:
