**About Us:** SRS-Women in Nuclear (SRS-WIN) is a chapter of U.S. Women in Nuclear (U.S. WIN) and is a member of the U.S. WIN Region II organization. SRS-WIN strategic objectives are the same as U.S. WIN. The organization provides opportunities for nuclear professionals to develop leadership skills, network, and provide public education outreach to the Central Savannah River Area about the benefits of nuclear science, technology, environmental stewardship, clean energy, and national security. The chapter is made up of employees and retirees from the U.S. Department of Energy, U.S. Forest Service-Savannah River, Savannah River Nuclear Solutions, Batelle Savannah River Alliance, Savannah River Remediation, and Centerra. #### **Scholarship Rules and Requirements:**

- Must be a current female high school senior in the Central Savannah River Area (CSRA).
  o Homeschool and Charter school are acceptable.
- Must plan to attend a 2 or 4-year college or university in Georgia or South Carolina after graduation.
- Must declare a STEM related major.
- Must have a minimum high school GPA of 2.8
- Must submit a 500 minimum word essay on "Why do you want to pursue a major/career in STEM?"
  - Essay must be typed in Times New Roman, 12pt font, and double-spaced.
  - Title page must include your name, name of school, and date.
- Essay must be submitted to <u>SRS-WIN@srs.gov</u> no later than March 31, 2025.
  - When submitting, include name, email address, best contact number, and address.
    - Professional headshot and/or resume are required to include in your packet.
