Face to Face / Learn@Home Students

*These are students who plan to be face-to-face students during Semester 2. Students will attend face-to-face when school is open and will “**Learn @ Home**” during times of school closure due to COVID-19.

- All Face-to-Face students will begin Learn@Home instruction on **Thursday, January 14, 2021.** Students should check Canvas for specific instructions from their teachers. Teachers will post expectations, homework, meeting times, etc. via Canvas.
- ELA and Science classes will meet on **Fridays, January 15th and 22nd and then on Mondays and Wednesdays.** Social Studies and Math classes will meet on **Tuesdays and Thursdays.** Please check the Canvas pages for meeting days for the following classes: Fine Arts, PE, Health, and Foreign Language classes. All classes will meet during the scheduled time of the class period.
- There will be no classes on Monday, January 18th in honor of Martin Luther King, Jr day.
- If necessary, Face-to-Face Students will be able to pick up textbooks and resources at Davidson between Monday, **January 11 from 4-6 PM and Tuesday, January 12 from 9-11 AM. Students will be notified if they will need new textbooks/resources by the teachers.**
- DFA will tentatively resume Face to Face instruction on **Tuesday, January 26, 2021** pending further advisement from public health agencies.
- Decisions regarding return date will be communicated by RCSS on **Wednesday, January 20, 2021.**
- Assignments must be completed to be considered present.
- Report Cards will be mailed out next week
