



Dual Enrollment

- Take the SAT/ACT: Log on to collegeboard.com or actstudent.org and register to take either the SAT or the ACT standardized test. Make sure to have your test scores sent directly to the University of West Georgia. (Codes – SAT: 5900, ACT: 0878)
- **2. Apply to UWG**: Log on to **westga.edu/applynow** and follow the directions to complete the application process. *Application fee is not required for Dual Enrollment.*
- 3. **Send Required Documentation**: Official test scores, official high school transcripts, and Dual Enrollment Participation Agreement. Please have all forms correctly signed, sealed, and sent to the UWG Admissions Office.
- 4. UWG Admission Decision: To check your admission status, visit go.westga.edu.
